ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS Doctor of Education in Health Professions (Ed.D.)

The Ed.D. program begins in the fall and spring semesters. Required application materials can be <u>submitted as they are completed</u>, <u>but all materials must be received</u> <u>before admission consideration</u>. Review of completed applicant files requires 3 to 4 weeks.

Complete applications are reviewed on a rolling basis

The following criteria must be met:

- Have a master's or higher academic degree from a regionally accredited institution
- A minimum graduate grade point average (GPA) of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale
- Completion of a course in statistics
- An interview may be required

Applicants whose first language is not English must prove <u>English proficiency</u> prior to admission review.

Meeting admission criteria does not guarantee admission into the program. Allen College uses a holistic admission review. The process balances academic achievement, work experience, extra-curricular involvement, leadership, community service, diversity, as well as, other applicable life experiences. Top applicants are accepted each term.
