

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Doctor of Education in Health Professions (Ed.D.)

The Ed.D. program begins in the fall and spring semesters. Required application materials can be submitted as they are completed, but all materials must be received before admission consideration. Review of completed applicant files requires 3 to 4 weeks.

Complete applications are reviewed on a rolling basis

The following criteria must be met:

- Have a master's or higher academic degree from a regionally accredited institution
- A minimum graduate grade point average (GPA) of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale
- Completion of a course in statistics
- An interview may be required

Applicants whose first language is not English must prove [English proficiency](#) prior to admission review.

Meeting admission criteria does not guarantee admission into the program. Allen College uses a holistic admission review. The process balances academic achievement, work experience, extra-curricular involvement, leadership, community service, diversity, as well as, other applicable life experiences. Top applicants are accepted each term.
