#### Total Estimated Cost of Program:

The total estimated cost of direct costs (tuition and fees) for the DOT program if completed in nine consecutive semesters with an estimated 1.5% increase on tuition and fees from one academic year to the next would be \$98,885 (not including indirect costs). Semesters range in credits from 7 to 16 credits a semester with 2-7 credits being clinical courses, generating the overall project cost of \$98,885.
