ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Public Health (PH)

The PH program begins twice each year in the fall and spring. Required application materials can be <u>submitted as they are completed</u>, <u>but all materials must be received before admission consideration</u>. Completed applicant files are reviewed on a rolling basis, and the process requires 3 to 4 weeks.

Enrollment is granted for a specific term. All admission criteria must be maintained, including satisfactory completion of required general education courses prior to beginning the program.

Early Applicants

The following criterion must be met:

- Completed fewer than 25 college credits
- Minimum high school cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- 72 general education hours must be completed before starting the program

Transfer Applicants

The following criterion must be met:

- Transfer applicants must have earned a minimum of 25 college credits prior to admission consideration.
- A minimum college cumulative grade point average of 2.7 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Earned a grade of C- or higher in all prerequisite general education courses
- 72 general education hours must be completed before starting the program

Applicants whose first language is not English must prove <u>English proficiency</u> prior to admission consideration.

Meeting admission criteria does not guarantee admission into the program. Allen College uses a holistic admission review. The process balances academic achievement, work experience, extra-curricular involvement, leadership, community service, diversity, as well as other applicable life experiences. Top applicants are accepted each term.
