## ALLEN COLLEGE GRANT FOR RURAL STUDENTS

Allen College was awarded a U.S. Department of Education Grant for Rural Postsecondary and Economic Development over a three-year period from October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2025. The aim of our grant project is to increase the number of high school students enrolling at Allen College who attended a high school with a rural locale code within 50 miles of Waterloo.

There are 40 high schools within our project service area. As a part of our program, Allen College will be working with these school districts to raise awareness for healthcare professions through a combination of in-person and online educational opportunities. We will be providing services to assist students in transitioning to higher education. We are also able to award over \$700,000 in scholarships throughout the duration of the grant to eligible students who graduated from these high schools.

Macy Harris (macy.harris@allencollege.edu) has been hired as a Community Outreach Coordinator to work with the school districts and develop programming.

\*Please note: Not all students who graduate from the high schools on this list will be eligible to receive a scholarship. There are a designated number of scholarships available each year to students who qualify. Students' first full year at Allen College must be during the duration of the grant period to be considered.
